The top Migration bottling from the Sonoma Coast, a barrel selection of top lots become the M>. Aromas of ripe bing cherry, baked strawberry tart and dusty roadside blackberries combine. Plenty of warm spices coming from the 15 months in 50% new French oak. The palate is velveteen and lush. Warm spices, Mexican chocolate and dense ripe bing cherry with a touch of toasty vanilla and sea spray salinity play harmoniously.
